

Year 1 Non-fiction

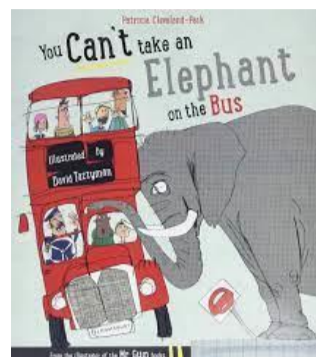
